PREFACE:

This Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is prepared in compliance with the Statewide Planning, Metropolitan Planning Rules jointly issued by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (23 CFR Part 450) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (49 CFR Part 613). This document lists the transportation improvements planned to be carried out in the next four federal fiscal years in compliance with the Interim Guidance, issued on September 2, 2005, for Implementing Key SAFETEA_LU Provisions on Planning, Environment, and Air Quality for Joint FHWA/FTA Authorities. This TIP covers four -year period from October 2006 through September 2010.

The TIP shall include:

1. All transportation projects, or identified phases of a project, (including pedestrian walkways, bicycle transportation facilities and transportation enhancement projects) within the metropolitan planning area proposed for funding under title 23, U.S.C. (including Federal Lands Highway projects) and the Federal Transit Act, excluding safety projects funded under 23 U.S.C. 402, emergency relief projects (except those involving substantial functional, locational and capacity changes), and planning and research activities (except those funded with NHS, STP, and/or MA funds).
2. The projects that are consistent with the transportation plan.
3. All regionally significant transportation projects for which FHWA or FTA approval is required whether or not the projects are to be funded with title 23, U.S.C., or Federal Transit Act funds. The examples of such projects are an addition of an interchange to the Interstate System with state, local, and/or private funds, demonstration projects not funded under title 23, U.S.C., or the Federal Transit Act, etc.
4. Sufficient descriptive material (type of work, termini, length, etc.) to identify the project or phase.
5. Estimated total cost.
6. The amount of federal funds proposed to be obligated during each program year.
7. Proposed source of federal and non-federal funds.
8. Identification of recipient/subrecipient and state and local agencies responsible for carrying out the project.

Projects proposed for FHWA and/or FTA funding that are not considered by the state and the MPO to be of appropriate scale for individual identification in a given program year may be grouped by function, geographic area, and work type using applicable classifications under 23 CFR 771.117 (c) and (d). [Categorical Exclusions, Environmental Impacts]

INTRODUCTION:

The formal transportation planning activities in the Jonesboro Metropolitan Area began in 2003 when the cities of Jonesboro, Brookland, Bono, and Bay and Craighead County agreed with the State of Arkansas to participate in establishing the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible for comprehensive transportation planning. The MPO prepared the 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The LRTP addressed all transportation modes and arrived at the project listing for transportation implementation for the next twenty-year period. This TIP will become a part of the LRTP.

PURPOSE:

The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act – A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA – LU) requires that the metropolitan transportation planning process includes development of a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP is a short range transportation capital improvement plan. This document provides the guide used by federal, state, and local governments to implement transportation projects within the metropolitan planning area. It also identifies how the MPO will use federal, state, and local financial resources to implement these projects. To be eligible for any level of federal funding, a project must be in the Long Range Transportation Plan and a Transportation Improvement Program.

SAFETEA - LU funding for the next four-year period of the TIP is available under title 23, U.S.C., and the Federal Transit Act. SAFETEA – LU has three new programs: the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), the Coordinated Border Infrastructure Program (CBI), and the Safe Routes to School Program (SRSP).

DEFINITION OF AREA:

In 2003, the State Governor designated the Jonesboro Area Transportation Study (JATS) Policy Committee as the Metropolitan Planning Organization. The Jonesboro Area Transportation Study comprises of five signatories: the Cities Jonesboro, Brookland, Bono, and Bay and the County of Craighead, and the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. The area map shows the physical boundary of the Jonesboro MPO area.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PROCESS:

PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS:

In accordance with Section 134(h) (2) of Title 23 U.S.C., as amended, the Jonesboro Area Transportation Study Policy Committee approves the following procedures pertaining to project selection during FY 2005 - FY 2007.

1. The approved Transportation Improvement Program shall be utilized for programming projects within the metropolitan area.
2. Any projects listed in the first year of the approved Transportation Improvement Program shall be considered in the first priority and may be implemented as soon as plans are completed and funds are appropriated.

3. Should any project not be implemented from the first priority, then projects should be selected from the second year which shall be considered the second priority, and, those projects may be implemented as plans are completed and funds are appropriated.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PROCESS

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

The Jonesboro Area Transportation Study MPO published a notice in the Jonesboro Sun on July 16, 2006 informing the public of its intent to prepare FY 2007 – FY 2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The citizens were advised to request a copy of the proposed TIP via mail, fax, or e-mail. This notice initiated a one-month period to gather public comments on the proposed Transportation Improvement Program.

The MPO staff e-mailed the copy of public notice and the list of proposed projects to all the Policy Committee and the Technical Advisory Committee members with a request to give the proposed list a wider publicity for the citizens to review the proposed projects and comment.

The draft FY 2007 – FY 2-10 Transportation Improvement Program was posted on the MPO website at www.jonesboro.org/MPO/mpo.htm. In addition, the MPO staff e-mailed the newsletter, "Metro-Mobility Talks," to a multitude of addresses including city employees, media, chamber of commerce, and the citizens. The newsletter that included the proposed TIP requested the recipients to comment on the proposed projects and suggest any other projects that may be included in the list.

General Comments:

The MPO published the legal advertisement in the Sun on July 16, 2006 opening a thirty-day public review and comment period.

1. Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD)

At the request of AHTD, the major widening of US 49 from Valley View to Gibson Switch was moved from FY 2007 to FY 2006. However, on August 15, 2006, this project was added to FY 2007 projects at the request of AHTD.

2. J. Harmon, 2021 Watt Street, Jonesboro

Mr. Harmon has requested that Nestle Road and Rogers Chapel Road may be included into the state highway system and developed as a bypass to relieve traffic on US 49 (Stadium Road). He also requested to construct an over-bridge at the railroad crossing at Nettleton Avenue and Highland Drive. This crossing is the most congested crossing because of the new mall on Highland Drive.
