## **2023 NEA Adult Co-Ed**

### **Volleyball League**

USA Volleyball Rules for 2022-2023 shall govern play insofar as they do not conflict with the rules stated herein:

Prior to the start of each match, the official shall conduct a coin toss between the captains of each team. The official will ask the winner of the toss whether their team chooses to:

- a. Serve / Receive
- b. Select the playing area
- c. The loser of the toss will be given the remaining choice.

The net height will be 7 feet 4 inches.

A match will consist of the best of three games, games will be to 25 except for the third game (if necessary) which will only be to 15, games must be decided by at least 2 points, with no cap. All games will use rally scoring.

There will be no uniform requirement for league play, but same color shirt is preferred.

Substitutions may be made during any dead ball period.

Game will consist of 6-on-6, but can be played with a minimum of 4 players. No more than 2 men may be on the court at any time.

Any ball hitting an overhead obstruction (backboard, ceiling, support beams, etc.) shall remain in play providing the ball remains on the same side of the net, the team has a hit remaining, and it does not occur on the serve.

Players are not allowed to “block” or “spike” the serve.

Teams are only allowed 1 timeout per game – 60 seconds in length.

Only team captains may discuss rule interpretations with the official.

For players to be eligible to play in the post-season tournament, players must have played in at least two matches during the regular season. Captains will sign team roster before each match to verify which team members are participating.
